PREPARATION FOR GLEANING...IF AND WHEN...

Our goal: a pickup truck FULL of sweet corn from a farmer's field to feed the hungry in our area. We pick early in the "coolness" of the day.

Please wear: A hat, long sleeve shirt, gloves (optional, but recommended), long pants (optional), closed-toed shoes (no sandals, please)

Bring along: A sturdy shopping bag (cloth) in which to place picked corn before it goes into truck, bottled water, cash

This can be a family event — Children o.k., supervised by parents

Reminder — there are no bathroom facilities where we'll be picking. We hope to provide rest facilities (before and after) at a rendezvous point near the picking site. We've often been able to pick up snacks at that time or you may bring some along.



We will meet in the church parking lot and use our church bus. Because of limited space, participants may be asked to drive/carpool to the site, usually an hour plus drive from church. Maps will be provided. We hope to be back in Swansboro by noon.
