

SUMC Golf Fellowship

1. *The SUMC Golf Fellowship* is intended to help form new friendships, cultivate relationships among our church family and of course, for fun...it is open to men and women of all ages. Hopefully, it will also serve to give golfers a list of contacts when looking for a game apart from the SUMC golf schedule.
2. Groupings will be arranged in foursomes when possible. For the purpose of getting to know each other (and when necessary to make up foursomes), weekly pairings may be at random.
3. SUMC Golf will be played at Star Hill Golf Club and rates will be \$25.00 for 9-holes or \$35.00 for 18. Rates will apply for SUMC scheduled outings only. Except for the cost of cart, no additional fee is required of Star Hill members. The general playing rules listed below have been adopted to make outings more enjoyable for all and to help speed play. Play will be on a weekly basis.

Speed-up and General Playing Rules

- ❖ The playing format will be individual stroke play.
 - ❖ We're out to have fun, so play from whatever tee that fits your desire or skill level (white, gold, green, or red).
 - ❖ A player may improve their lie within one club length anywhere on the course, fairway or rough.
 - ❖ Once a player is 3 over par, please pick up and score a triple bogey.
 - ❖ Players may pick up if within a putter grip of the hole; or if another player awards a "gimme".
 - ❖ After a round, please turn your scorecard into the chair.
4. There will be no phone reminders, but an email reminder and request for confirmation will be sent several days in advance. *We must have an advance tally to inform the golf course, so an intent to play is necessary. If no confirmation is received, it will be assumed that a player will not be playing that week.*
 5. A player may opt to play either 9 or 18 holes, so please indicate in your email confirmation your intention of 9 or 18 holes. Unless otherwise noted, the first group will tee off at 1:04 pm. To have time to make last minute adjustments, it is requested that players arrive no later than 30-minutes before the first tee time.
 6. In case of late cancellations, you may give notice by calling Larry Philpott at 910-322-4736.
 7. If possible, players will be notified by email of inclement weather cancellations. Otherwise, a decision will be made at the golf course.
 8. Members are encouraged to invite friends and will be paired with the inviting member. Just indicate along with your confirmation that you're bringing a friend...and don't forget to include their name. As some already have, we hope guests will consider becoming regular members of the fellowship.
 9. An informal dinner for players and spouses will be held in November at Rucker Johns. TBA
