1. **Welcome/Concerns/Joys/Prayers** – Pres Jim Gamble and Chaplain John Lee.
2. **Next Fellowship Meeting & Program is Wednesday 18 April at 6:30 pm, LL#13.**
3. **Our Guest Speaker Tonight** – Ms Edie Reed of the **Broad Street Clinic** highlighted the many good things the clinic does in providing health care to qualified, uninsured, low income residents of the surrounding areas. A few examples: over \$4million in drugs free to the needy; partners with Carteret HealthCare for labs, x-rays, etc. The Clinic receives no federal or state funding—operations are donation supported.
4. **Sea Scout's** Skipper presented SUMM with the new Sea Scout Charter and briefed on activities: 2nd Place in Sailing Regatta; going to Virginia in May for Sea Scouting Academy; scouts available for local service projects; presented Certificate of Appreciation to Terry Proper; thanks to Ray Bihary for gift of a sailboat; more info at www.swansboroseascouts.org .
