



SUMM Fellowship Meeting Minutes 14 Nov 2018

1. **Welcome/Prayers** – President elect David overview of meeting/ Chaplain John Lee prayers
2. **Next Fellowship Meeting & Program is January 2019**
3. **Tonight's Guest Speaker** – Our Associate Pastor Adam Barth spoke of his witness, walk of faith, and his theological study,
Our Meal tonight = 3 chili pot from Larry Wicker, John Lee, and David Krawchuk; and drinks and desserts by Frank Cizerle.
4. **Peanut Ministry**. Inventory on hand 105 cases. Hurricane Florence water damaged 25 boxes of raw peanuts, about \$600 value. Some discussion and alternatives to where we now store raw peanuts due to ceiling water leaks and damage from the hurricane. We now store them in our peanut preparation room.
5. **Treasurer's Report** –checking balance about \$9,000. We are on track to spend our donation budget of \$30,000.

The Fellowship agreed that our VIP's ought to again this year receive a Christmas gift from the UMM—agreement on a holiday basket. Al agreed to coordinate this.

 - B. **December Program** – the Board unanimously agreed that due to local damages from Hurricane Florence, to **cancel this year's Christmas banquet** and to redirect the money previously budgeted for the banquet, to the local hurricane disaster fund within our Church. Therefore, **SUMM will donate \$1,000 to the SUMC local disaster relief fund**, in addition to the \$300 we received from a donor. The Board and Fellowship will discuss other options for a Church-wide event, perhaps in the Spring.
