Soup Kitchen

Food assistance activities are lunch meals, mobile soup kitchen, monthly food bank and support of church food pantries.

Over 172,000 meals have been served. Over 20,000 volunteer hours have been donated and six other church food pantries assisted in 2017.



Christmas Cheer

Established in the early 1970's, Christmas Cheer provides toys, bicycles, and food for over 5,100 people and over 3,000 children.

Each year, 300+ volunteers serve families through the Christmas Cheer program.



Homeless Shelter

Operating every day of the year, clients spend nights in the shelter and days in self-improvement activities. Basic and immediate needs are met.

In 2017, 300 homeless people were sheltered. Of these, 41% were families and veterans.



Caring Community Clinic

Open Monday through Friday and some Saturdays, eligible patients from ages 19 - 64 receive care and prescription assistance.

DENTAL

Established in 2017, the dental clinic is open Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday. Dental and other volunteers are essential to providing much needed care in the community.
