- Lisa Potts opened the meeting with prayer and lighting of the Christ candle.
- The Bake Sale (18 March) signup sheet was circulated. Bobbi Edge announced, by the end of the meeting that there were enough volunteers for the sale.
  - The price list for items at the sale was handed out.
- The Yard Sale (19-21 April) is still in need of 9 to 12 volunteers.
- No final decision for reentering the Barnum House has been given from the Trustees. However, the UMW have been asked to compile a list of items that need to be replaced from the Barnum House.
  - New storage location(s) for UMW supplies/items need to be obtained. Room 34/Bldg. 2?
- Special Events - 'Teatime Among the Holidays' (28 April) currently has 12 tables filled.
  - Vacant tables are still available.
  - Table confirmations need to be given to Patti Heller by 25 April.
  - Consensus was reached to purchase a 100-cup Hot Water Pot for approximately \$100; needed mainly for the yearly Tea events. Potholders will also be purchased.
  - Proceeds from this year's Tea event will be donated to 1) the Coastal Carolina Center for Women's Ministries, 2) the Methodist Home for Children Transitional Home and 3) Undesignated Mission Funds.
  - Circle Leaders are asked to have their Circles vote on a theme for the next two years Tea events. Two suggestions are 'Bible Stories' and 'Tea for All Seasons'.
  - A possible short presentation, from one of the recipients of our proceeds, is being considered.
- Special Events – Women of Wisdom Conference (29 September) keynote speakers were discussed, as well as box lunches and workshop ideas.
  - Lisa Potts will be contacting possible guest speakers and needed workshop leaders.
- Charlie Krawchuk reported on recently received thank you notes and prayer concerns.
  - Swansboro Elementary School is asking for volunteer help in classrooms to read with younger students, assist with learning sight words and basic math skills.
- Treasurer – Bonnie Bihary reports that the current balance for SUMW account is \$2976.96.
  - Circle Treasurers are reminded to place money pouches in the wooden box on Sunday mornings following their monthly Circle meetings.
